

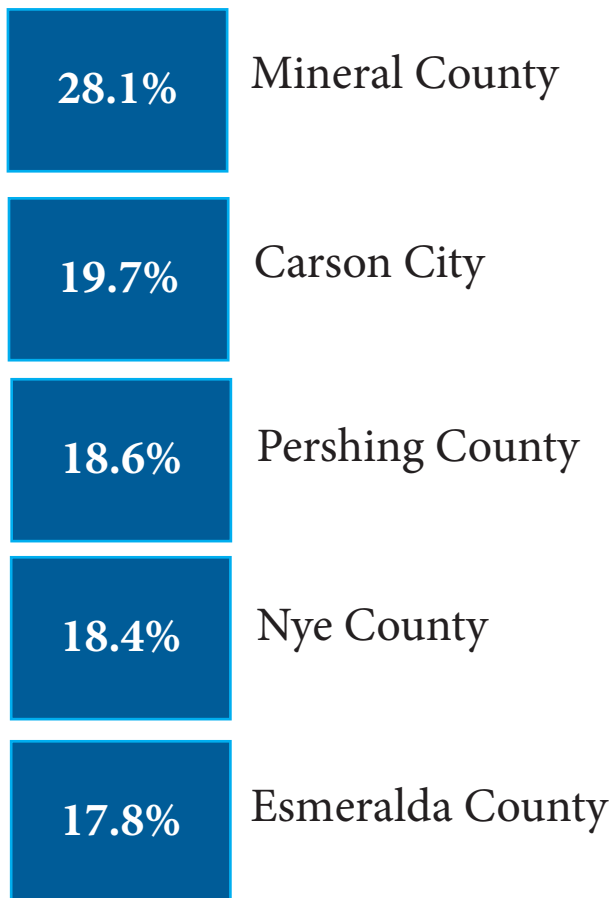

Counties with the highest poverty rate

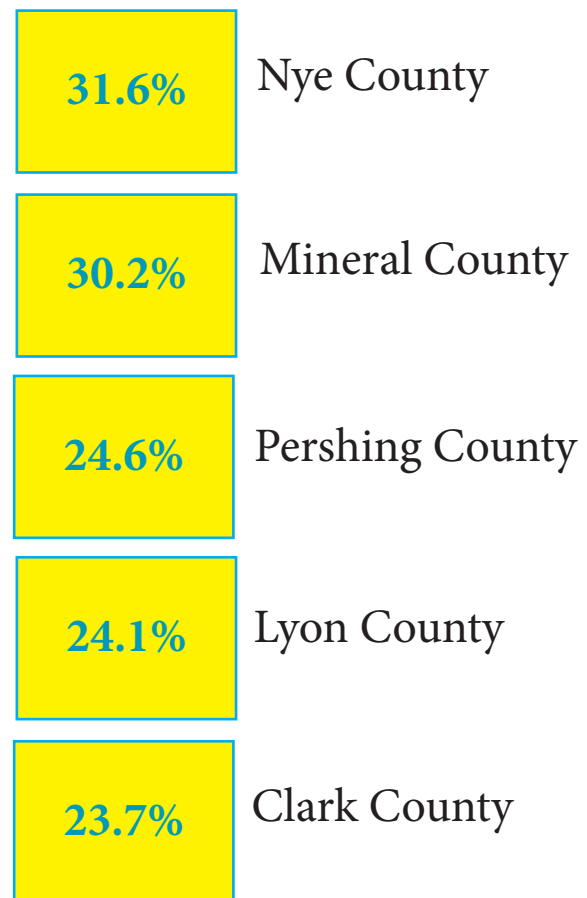
